

REQUIREMENTS FOR FAMILIES OF THE EUROPEAN PASSPORT HOLDERS: (ESC)

TO APPLY FOR A ESC VISA AT THE EMBASSY OF SPAIN, YOU MUST FIRST COLLECT A **NATIONAL VISA APPLICATION FORM** FROM THE BLS WEBSITE (ADDRESS GIVEN BELOW). THEN YOU MUST MAKE AN APPOINTMENT BY CALLING **+88 09606556656** (SPAIN VISA APPLICATION CENTRE) FROM 14:00 TO 15:30 PM FROM SUNDAY TO WEDNESDAY. THE SPAIN VISA APPLICATION CENTRE WILL GIVE YOU AN APPOINTMENT DATE AND TIME, AS EARLY AS AVAILABLE, TO SUBMIT YOUR ESC VISA APPLICATION TO THE EMBASSY OF SPAIN ALONG WITH THE SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS. PLEASE KEEP IN MIND THAT IT USUALLY TAKES FIFTEEN WORKING DAYS TO PROCESS ESC VISA APPLICATIONS.

FOR SPOUSE

1. APPLICATION FORM (SCHENGEN): ONE ORIGINAL AND ONE PHOTOCOPY WITH PASSPORT SIZE PHOTOS (WHITE BACKGROUND).
2. APPLICANT'S PASSPORT WITH A VALIDITY OF AT LEAST SIX MONTHS AFTER THE INTENDED STAY (ORIGINAL AND PHOTOCOPIES).
3. SPOUSE'S PASSPORT (PRESENT AND OLD), PHOTOCOPY OF ALL PAGES DULY NOTARISED BY A SPANISH NOTARY PUBLIC.
4. **SPANISH CITIZEN:**
 - RESIDENT CARD OF THE SPONSOR (ORIGINAL AND PHOTOCOPY, OR DULY NOTARIZED BY A SPANISH PUBLIC NOTARY).
 - SPOUSE'S LITERAL BIRTH CERTIFICATE FROM SPAIN AS HE/SHE IS A SPANISH PASSPORT HOLDER (ORIGINAL AND PHOTOCOPY, OR DULY NOTARIZED BY A SPANISH PUBLIC NOTARY).
 - MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE REGISTERED IN THE 'REGISTRO CIVIL CENTRAL' OF SPAIN.

- SPOUSE'S 'CERTIFICADO DE REGISTRO DE CIUDADANO DE LA UNIÓN', DULY NOTARISED BY A SPANISH PUBLIC NOTARY.
5. MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE AND "NIKAH NAMA" ISSUED BY THE REGISTRAR OF MARRIAGES, IN ENGLISH AND BENGALI. THIS CERTIFICATE MUST BE LEGALIZED BY MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS (MOFA) AND AFTERWARDS TRANSLATED IN SPANISH LANGUAGE. THIS CERTIFICATE MUST BE LESS THAN THREE MONTHS OLD AT THE TIME OF SUBMISSION OF THE APPLICATION (ORIGINAL).
 6. AUTHORIZED LETTER FROM THE SPOUSE THAT HE/SHE WANTS TO TAKE THE SPOUSE TO SPAIN (ORIGINAL AND PHOTOCOPY, OR DULY NOTARIZED BY A SPANISH NOTARY PUBLIC).
 7. POLICE CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE FROM THE HOME MINISTRY OF BANGLADESH. THIS CERTIFICATE MUST BE LEGALIZED BY MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS (MOFA) AND AFTERWARDS TRANSLATED IN SPANISH LANGUAGE
 8. ORIGINAL BIRTH CERTIFICATE ISSUED BY THE REGISTRAR'S OFFICE IN ENGLISH. THIS CERTIFICATE MUST BE LEGALIZED BY MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS (MOFA) AND AFTERWARDS TRANSLATED IN SPANISH LANGUAGE.

9. MEDICAL CERTIFICATE WHERE IT MUST BE MENTIONED THAT THE APPLICANT IS FREE FROM ANY COMMUNICABLE DISEASES. THIS CERTIFICATE MUST BE LEGALIZED BY MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS (MOFA) AND AFTERWARDS TRANSLATED IN SPANISH LANGUAGE.
10. DOCUMENTS WHICH SHOW THAT THE REAGRUPANT LIVES IN SPAIN, SUCH AS VIDA LABORAL, CERTIFICADO DE EMPADRONAMIENTO DE LA UNIDAD FAMILIAR, DECLARACIÓN I.R.P.F....
11. **IF THE EU CITIZEN IS STAYING IN BANGLADESH DURING THE TIME OF VISA APPLICATION, ALL DOCUMENTS WILL BY CERTIFIED BY THE CONSULAR SECTION INSTEAD OF A SPANISH NOTARY PUBLIC.**

FOR CHILDREN

 - REAGRUPANT'S 'CERTIFICADO DE REGISTRO DE CIUDADANO DE LA UNIÓN', PHOTOCOPY DULY NOTARIZED BY A SPANISH NOTARY PUBLIC.
5. ORIGINAL BIRTH CERTIFICATE ISSUED BY THE REGISTRAR'S OFFICE IN ENGLISH. THIS CERTIFICATE MUST BE LEGALIZED BY MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS (MOFA) AND AFTERWARDS TRANSLATED IN SPANISH LANGUAGE.
6. AUTHORIZED LETTER FROM THE REAGRUPANT THAT HE/SHE WANTS TO TAKE THE CHILDREN TO SPAIN (ORIGINAL AND PHOTOCOPY, OR DULY NOTARIZED BY A SPANISH NOTARY PUBLIC).
7. MEDICAL CERTIFICATE WHERE IT MUST BE MENTIONED THAT THE APPLICANT IS FREE FROM ANY COMMUNICABLE DISEASES. THIS CERTIFICATE MUST BE LEGALIZED BY MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS (MOFA) AND AFTERWARDS TRANSLATED IN SPANISH LANGUAGE.
8. POLICE CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE FROM THE HOME MINISTRY OF BANGLADESH, THIS CERTIFICATE MUST BE LEGALIZED BY MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS (MOFA) AND AFTERWARDS TRANSLATED IN SPANISH LANGUAGE. IF THE APPLICANT IS BELOW 16 YEARS OLD, THE CRIMINAL RECORD IS NOT NEEDED.
9. DOCUMENTS WHICH SHOW THAT THE REAGRUPANT LIVES IN SPAIN, SUCH AS VIDA LABORAL, CERTIFICADO DE EMPADRONAMIENTO DE LA UNIDAD FAMILIAR, DECLARACIÓN I.R.P.F....
10. IF THE APPLICANT IS A MINOR, POWER OF ATTORNEY OF THE PARENTS BEFORE SPANISH NOTARY PUBLIC IN FAVOUR OF A REPRESENTATIVE OLDER THAN 18 TO SUBMIT THE VISA APPLICATION, COLLECT THE PASSPORT AND REPRESENT THEM IN ANY ACTION CONCERNING THE VISA PROCEDURE BEFORE THE EMBASSY OF SPAIN IN DHAKA.

11. NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE FROM FATHER OR MOTHER (IF THEY ARE NOT APPLICANT)
12. **IF THE EU CITIZEN IS STAYING IN BANGLADESH DURING THE TIME OF VISA APPLICATION, ALL DOCUMENTS WILL BY CERTIFIED BY THE CONSULAR SECTION INSTEAD OF A SPANISH NOTARY PUBLIC.**

5. **EUROPEAN CITIZEN DIFFERENT FROM SPAIN:**
 - REAGRUPANT'S 'CERTIFICADO DE REGISTRO DE CIUDADANO DE LA UNIÓN', PHOTOCOPY DULY NOTARISED BY A SPANISH PUBLIC NOTARY.
 - ORIGINAL BIRTH CERTIFICATE ISSUED BY THE REGISTRAR'S OFFICE IN ENGLISH. THIS CERTIFICATE MUST BE LEGALIZED BY MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS (MOFA) AND AFTERWARDS TRANSLATED IN SPANISH LANGUAGE.
6. AUTHORIZED LETTER FROM THE REAGRUPANT THAT HE/SHE WANTS TO TAKE HER/HIS PARENTS TO SPAIN (ORIGIANL AND PHOTOCOPY, OR DULY NOTARIZED BY A SPANISH NOTARY PUBLIC).
7. POLICE CLEARENCE CERTIFICATE FROM THE HOME MINISTRY OF BANGLADESH, THIS CERTIFICATE MUST BE LEGALIZED BY MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS (MOFA) AND AFTERWARDS TRANSLATED IN SPANISH LANGUAGE.
8. MEDICAL CERTIFICATE WHERE IT MUST BE MENTIONED THAT THE APPLICANT IS FREE FROM ANY COMMUNICABLE DISEASES. THIS CERTIFICATE MUST BE LEGALIZED BY MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS (MOFA) AND AFTERWARDS TRANSLATED IN SPANISH LANGUAGE.

10. DOCUMENTS WHICH SHOW THAT THE REAGRUPANT LIVES IN SPAIN, SUCH AS VIDA LABORAL, CERTIFICADO DE EMPADRONAMIENTO DE LA UNIDAD FAMILIAR, DECLARACIÓN I.R.P.F....
